# THE SPBILF PRIVATE LAW PRIZE



The 2018 SPBILF hosted the award ceremony of the very first laureate of the SPBILF Private Law Prize. The Prime Minister of Russia, Dmitry Medvedev, personally conferred the Prize upon the 2018 Laureate, Orsolya Toth, associate professor of commercial law at the University of Nottingham.

The Prize amounts to 10 million rubles.

This global academic award is tasked with recognizing the highest academic class of the winner, while its financial component is intended to help with the implementation of research ideas of international importance.

Unparalleled in the intellectual depth of its contending papers, the authority of its Expert Committee, and the size of the cash reward offered, the SPBILF Prize will be to the international community of legal professionals as prestigious an award in private law as the Nobel Prize is to the respective professional communities.
